

Saint Francis Home Visitation Protocol

Effective January 8, 2022 per California Public Health Department regulations

Family Virtual and Indoor or Patio visits are by appointment; please contact the front desk to schedule at least 24hrs prior to coming (714) 542-0381.

- Be prepared to go through screening, which now includes checking your temperature, answering
 health questions and the use of hand sanitizer (all standard procedures due to CoVid-19). All
 visitors are required to wear a facemask and use it properly; we have placed instructions on how to
 use these all around our facility for your convenience.
- For visitors two years of age or older and regardless of proof of any vaccine or booster: During Jan. 7- Feb. 7·2022, prior to visiting our facility in or outdoors you are obliged to provide the following proof:
 - PCR Negative Test within 48 hours prior to entry
 - FDA approved Negative Antigen Test results taken within 24 hours of entry

- 4 visitors per outdoor visit (4 max/visit)
